#### Method

- \$40/month membership fee
- Costs of product & shipping when ordering from manufacturers
- There are also commissions on each sale of your items and storage fees to consider which vary based on your item size and weight
- Hosting: \$2.75/month (Hostgator)
- Domain: around \$10/year (Namecheap)
- When you expand, it may include other spend for example, email marketing costs (ConvertKit), and course hosting costs (Teachable).
- Can also pay to grow your team of writers and assistants

#### Method

Purchase properties that you can rent out. Rent should cover expenses like mortgage, property taxes, homeowner's insurance and make you extra monthly passive income. Dividends are payments from a company to owners of the company's stock. Dividends are very passive.

### Startup costs

- May cost between \$20,000 to \$200,000 (or more) for the down payment on a home
- You can also find other financing options like acquiring financing from other investors.
- Home prices and rent prices can waver.
- In general, your dividend income received can be around 3-4% per year. If you put in around \$10,000 in dividend stocks, you could make around \$300 per year.
- Stocks and dividends may waver in price.
